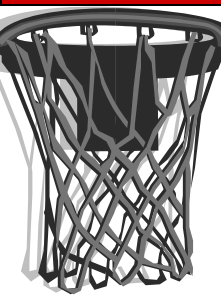

Kristen Dicalogero is a former four-year starting shooting guard at Assumption College. At Walpole High School, Kristen earned 11 varsity letters while playing soccer, basketball, and track. In track, she made two State tournament appearances for the shot put and discus. In Kristen's senior year the basketball team won the Division II State title. In addition, she was a Daily Transcript and Bay State League all-star for three years and concluded her high school career with an appearance in the Hoffman All-Star game.

Her achievements at Walpole earned Kristen a full athletic scholarship at Assumption where she made the all-tournament team in the school's 2006 annual tournament. She also obtained a degree in Business Communications and minored in Psychology. Kristen is currently in the process of getting a Masters degree in Sports Leadership at Northeastern University. She is the girls' varsity basketball coach at the Southfield School in Brookline, MA. The varsity basketball program was started by Kristen in the 2008-2009 season; where the young team only went 1-14. Within one year the team is now currently 8-1 and off to a great start. Kristen has coached soccer at the middle school and JV level at Southfield as well. Following her passion for basketball, Kristen has coached the Bay State Legends for a year and strives to continue to teach young basketball players important skills, techniques, and sportsmanship.

Marquis currently coaches Dexter School boy's basketball program as an Assistant Coach for the Varsity team. In 2006, he led Stonehill College to its first Division II NCAA Final Four berth in school history. He also led the team in scoring and rebounding. During his senior year, he was recognized as Athlete of the Year at Stonehill College, First Team All-Conference for the Northeast 10, and MVP of NCAA Tournament, Northeast Region.

During the summer of 2005, he played in the Arafura Games in Darwin, Australia representing United States College Division II Basketball, where the team won a gold medal.

Upon graduation, Marquis Taylor was an assistant coach at Mansfield High School and assisted them to their first playoff berth in 8+ years. Marquis also assists Kristen in coaching the Southfield varsity basketball team.
